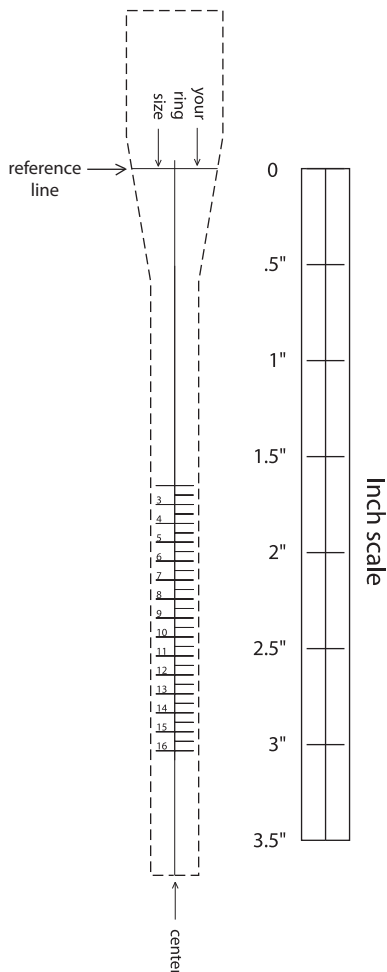
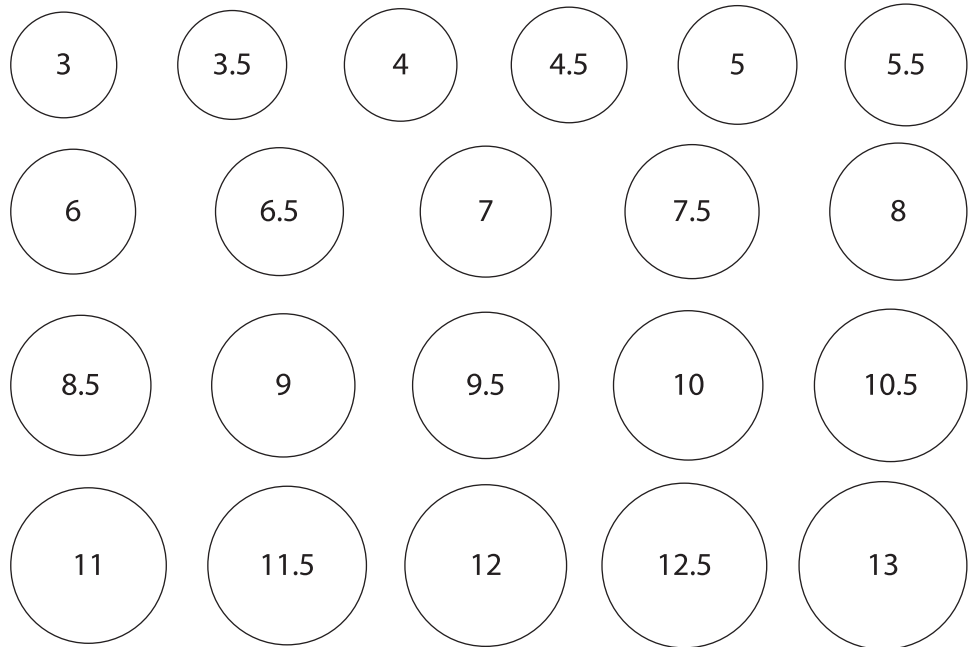


Determining Your Ring Size

- Check printer settings: set to print actual size.
- Place a ruler on the inch scale below and verify print size is accurate.

Method 1: Measure an existing ring

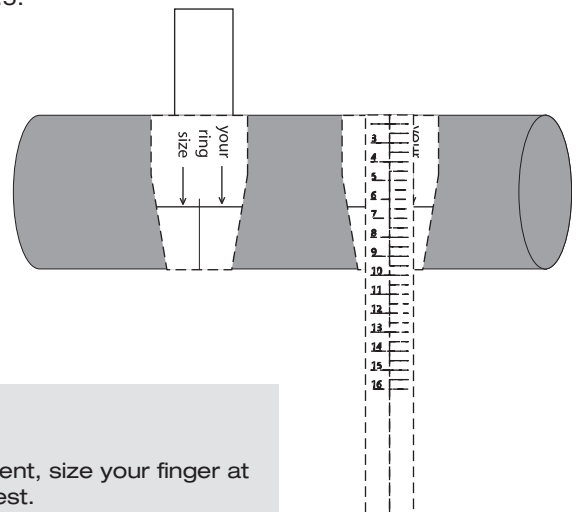
- Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. (The traditional ring finger is the finger between the little finger and the middle finger.)
- Place the ring over the circles to the right, matching the inside of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
- If the ring falls between two sizes, select the larger size.



Method 2: Measure your finger with our paper ring-sizer

If you do not have an existing ring to measure, you can use our paper ring sizer.

- Cut out ring sizer on dotted line.
- Wrap ring sizer snugly around the widest part of the finger and align on center line.
- Reference line should show on both sides of scale: read size from closest line below reference line. This example = size 6.5.
- If your size falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.



Finger Measuring Tips

- For the most accurate measurement, size your finger at the end of the day, when it is largest.
- Avoid measuring cold fingers, as they will size smaller.
